Dear parents and carers,

ParentPay is a system where parents and carers can pay for things in school online instead of using cash, e.g. school dinners, trips and donations for fund-raising days such as Red Nose Day. Many of you will already be familiar with ParentPay if you have children at high school. It really does make things easier for everyone!

Letters were sent out last week explaining how to set up an account (if you don't already have one) and how to use it, including usernames and passwords.

Soon, Worth Valley Primary will be a 'cashless school' which will make us much more efficient—there will no longer be a need to bring any cash to school as all parents and staff will be using ParentPay.

Please endeavor to set up your ParentPay account during the holidays in order to facilitate an efficient transfer as soon as we return.
