Reception Visit to Lower Winskill Farm

Dear parents and carers,

Reception class will visit Lower Winskill Farm on Monday 17th June.

Lower Winskill is a working farm set in the spectacular limestone scenery overlooking Ribblesdale in the Yorkshire Dales National Park. The children will spend the day learning all about how a working farm runs; spending time with the animals and enjoying lots of interactive play.

The children will leave school at 9:00am and return in time for a normal collection at 3:20pm, depending on traffic.

Children must wear full school uniform with suitable walking footwear (no open toes). Please check the weather that day and ensure your child has a sun hat and sun cream applied at home and/or a waterproof coat if needed.

Children will need a packed lunch (school can provide this) and a refillable water bottle. The cost of the visit is £5 per child; the rest of the visit has been covered by a school grant awarded to Mrs Oram. This is a voluntary contribution, however if we do not receive sufficient funds the visit may have to be cancelled. The trip is now live on your parent pay account.
