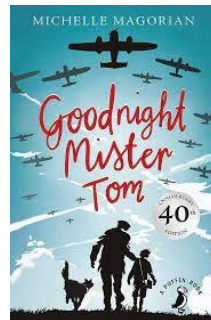




History

World War II is our topic for this half term. We will look at the Treaty of Versailles, life as a child during the war, the use of propaganda and VE-Day. Our topic will be enhanced through a visit to Murton Park, where we will experience areas of the war first hand.



English

This half term our book in English links nicely to our History topic. We will be creating setting descriptions, using dialogue in a narrative and creating a political public address.



Maths

Maths lessons this half term will cover symmetry, translation and co-ordinates in geometry. We will be revisiting decimals which will include multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will also be converting units of measure.



Computing

We will be completing and creating spreadsheets focusing on different formula and how they can be used effectively. We will link this to real life jobs where spreadsheets are used daily.



Science

We will look closely at life processes, life cycles of animals, insects, amphibians, birds and reptiles. During our lessons we will focus on the life and work of Jane Goodall and David Attenborough.



DT

This half term during DT week, we will research, plan, create and evaluate stuffed toys this half term. We will work together in groups to design and make characters from children's books for the children in year 1.



PSHE

RSHE is the focus across school for the last half term. We will explore different feelings and identify how the body grows and changes, including puberty.



Religious Education

We will look at the old and new covenant. We will discuss the lifeless code of moral demands and the concept of God's power to live for him.



Spanish

Going to the beach this half term is our focus in Spanish, we will look at vacations in Spain, asking how to visit the beach and giving directions.
