### What are we learning in Year 6?

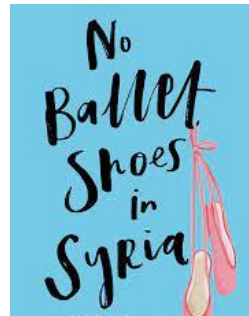


#### History

We will be investigating local histories from the Victorian to the inter-war period by exploring the census. We will learn about the census, its purpose and its changes over time. Children will link them to national events and research a local family or street.

#### English

This half term we are using no ballet shoes in Syria to understand the features of and create our own newspaper report, letter and character description.



#### Maths

Our focus in maths is on division; we will be learning how to complete long division questions.

We are also learning about fractions; adding/subtracting and multiplying fractions.



#### Computing

We are coders! This half term we are creating our very own text-adventurous game, developing our skills and ability to debug codes that are unsuccessful.



#### Science

Electricity is our topic this half term. We are learning to create circuits using wires, bulbs, batteries, motors and buzzers. We are also learning about voltage and how we can be safe around electricity.



#### DT

Our first DT project is textiles. We will be researching waistcoats, designing our own and creating a full size waistcoat, learning how to sew and use methods to add detail.



#### PSHE

Valuing differences is our theme for this half terms PSHE. We will be focusing on friendships and stereotypes



#### Religious Education

This half term we will focus on Hinduism. We will focus on Hindu belief in God and how Hindu people worship in different ways at home and in the Mandir.



#### Spanish

This half term we are using adjectives to describe where we live, locally, nationally and in relation to the world. We will compare Keighley to living in Spain.
