Year 5 Swimming Top-Up Sessions

We are pleased to inform parents and carers of Year 5 pupils that we have arranged a block of top-up swimming sessions for the summer term.

As many of you will remember, the children's swimming lessons in Year 4 were unfortunately cut short due to the refurbishment of Keighley Leisure Centre. In order to ensure pupils still have the opportunity to develop this important life skill, we have organised additional sessions for them.

The sessions will take place every Friday from 17th April to 17th July, from 9.45am to 10.45am.

Please ensure your child brings their swimming kit every Friday. This should include:

- Swimming costume or shorts (no two-pieces and no knee-length shorts)
- A towel
- Long hair should be tied up or plaited
- No jewellery is allowed other than small studs in ears



Swimming is not only an essential life skill, it is a statutory element of the national curriculum and therefore weekly attendance is mandatory.
